IMPORTANT: A CLUB ANNUAL REPORT MUST BE PUBLISHED TO BE CONSIDERED
FOR DISTRICT GOVERNOR CITATION.

MEMBERSHIP (Must meet 3 of 7)

- *Net Gain in Membership:*
 - Small Club – Net 1 – Less than 30 members
 - Medium Club – Net 2 – 30 – 49 members
 - Medium Club – Net 3 – 50 – 99 members
 - Large Club – Net 4 – 100 members or more
- Must have a Membership Committee and chair listed on DACdb Membership Committee
- Net increase in female members
- Net increase in Under 40 members
- Net increase in Over 40 members
- Held a membership awareness meeting – can be in partnership with other Rotary clubs
- Have or establish a new member orientation program

LITERACY (New program for your club) (Must meet 3 of 5)

- *Establish a reading program at a local elementary school to aid in increasing reading levels at 3rd Grade (In the write-up, please indicate the 3rd Grade Reading Level in your school district)*
- Distribute dictionaries to elementary school students
- Sponsor a speech or essay program at a school or Boys and Girls Club or similar organization
- Erect a Free Library
- Sponsor a robotics team or similar STEM effort

ROTARY FOUNDATION (Must meet 3 of 5)*

- Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) goal met by the end of September 2019 (\$25/club member) sent in to The Rotary Foundation (\$25/member)
- *At least 10% of club members meet criteria for \$250 Club Members (\$200 Annual Fund/\$50 Polio). These are not Paul Harris Society Members but members reaching this goal for the first time.*
 - *If 25% of club members meet criteria for \$250 Club Members, it eliminates one of the three requirements for this section – only need to meet two of the five
- Club holds a Foundation event that is open to the public for Polio or Foundation Fundraising
- Club earns Star Club Status (\$100/capita)
- Increase club PolioPlus donations to \$50/capita

CLUB ADMINISTRATION (MUST MEET 3 OF 6)

- Establish club goals in Rotary Club Central by June 30, 2019
- Begin using the Engagement & Attendance Module in DACdb
- Publish a DACdb Club Directory and distribute to your membership
- *Update member DACdb data with the following (a must accomplishment)*
 - Birthdate including birth year
 - Photo
 - Contact info to include an email address and at least one phone number
 - Classification
 - Spouse's info is optional
 - Business info (optional but great for networking)
- Establish an Executive Secretary position to facilitate the updating of DACdb and Rotary Club Central
- Club by-laws are established and current

PUBLIC IMAGE (MUST MEET 3 of 5)

- *At least three Facebook Live videos showing the club working on a service project. Include video with links with submission*
- Club website and Facebook updated at least once a month
- Submit one press release a quarter on club service projects or other such activities
- Show that club received publicity in either a newspaper article or radio/TV spot for service projects, World Polio Day, etc.
- Highlight your club's Interact and/or Rotaract Clubs on your website, Facebook page or in the local newspaper or on local TV/radio
